

CULINARY ESCAPEDE FROM HUÉ TO HOI AN (VNEDAD-02)

4 days / 3 nights

A culinary experience in Central Vietnam, from the street food to the best restaurants in the region, including a traditional cooking class.

D1 HUÉ: ARRIVAL AND DISCOVERY OF REGIONAL PRODUCTS (D)

Upon arrival, **welcome by the local guide** at Hué airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Note: Rooms are available from 2 p.m.

Explore **Hué**, the ancient capital of Vietnam under the Nguyen Dynasty. Discover the Imperial City, the former imperial seat of the government. This is a great sprawling complex of temples, pavilions, moats, walls, gates, shops, museums and galleries, featuring art and costumes from various periods of the Vietnamese history.

Scenic tour in the evening by rickshaw through the picturesque streets of the old city to discover the "street food" in a warm atmosphere.

Overnight in Hué.

D2 HUÉ–DANANG–HOI AN (B/L/D)

After breakfast, an immersion in the heart of **Dong Ba Market**, located on the Perfume River. Constructed in 1899 under Thanh Thai's reign, it is the largest commercial center in Hue city, where you will find colourful fruit and vegetable stalls as well as spices, all used in the typical regional cuisine.

Lunch, tasting all the specialities of the Royal gastronomy of Hué.



VIETNAMESE TRADITIONAL FOOD

In the afternoon, depart to Danang via the Hai Van Pass. Upon arrival, **visit the Cham Archaeological Museum** with an extremely rich collection, tracing the history of this lost civilization.

Then, continue the journey to the port town of **Hoi An**, recognized as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. It is an exceptionally well-preserved port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. Its buildings and street plan reflect the influences, both indigenous and foreign, that have combined to produce this unique heritage site.

Check-in at the hotel upon arrival.

In the heart of the old town and along the Hoai River, dinner at "Moon River" restaurant, considered as one of the city's best addresses.

D3 HOI AN: COOKING CLASS (B/L)

After breakfast, depart for a **cooking class** with the team of **Street International Association**. This non-profit organization aims to teach street children skills in the field of the hotel and restaurant industry. After visiting the market to search for the ingredients necessary for the cooking lesson, participants will walk to the school and the lesson begins. Everyone will participate in preparing the dishes typical of the Central Vietnam region. The students at the school interact with the visitors, creating a fun atmosphere.

The course concludes with a **lunch at the restaurant** of the association.



SPRING ROLLS

Return back to the hotel and the rest of the day is at leisure.

Overnight in Hoi An.

D4 HOI AN–DANANG (B)

After breakfast, the time is at leisure at the hotel.

Note: Rooms shall be released by 12:00 p.m. (noon).

Depending on the flight schedule, transfer to Danang's airport for the departure flight.
